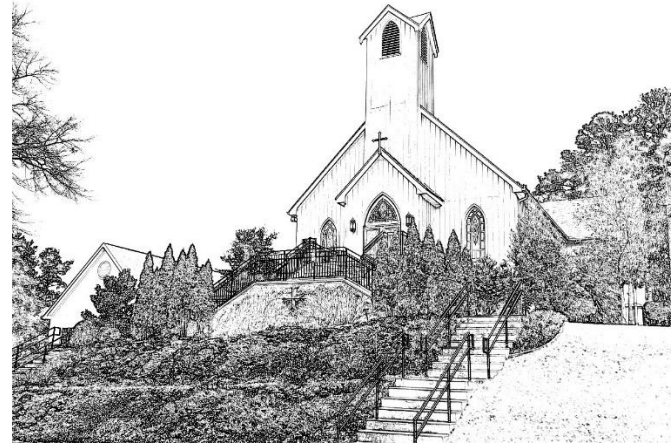
There will be Mass on July 4th, Independence Day, at 10am.
